Thank you for helping us continue this important work.

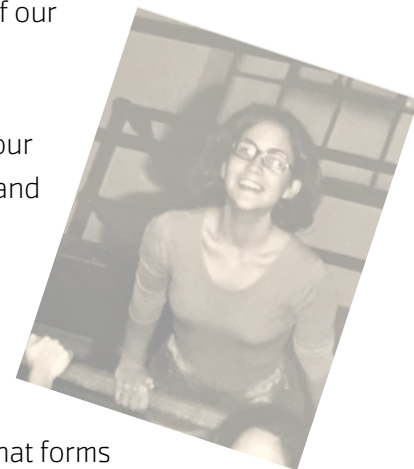
