**NOTICE**

There is a state of emergency in Ohio due to the prevalence of COVID-19. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3701.13, the Ohio Director of Health has issued several public health orders. **If a venue cannot comply with these orders, they are to work with Local Health Department to resolve any issues.**

**REQUIRED ITEMS TO SUBMIT:**

- Site Plan
  - Marked points of entry and exit (Marked with Arrows on Map)
  - Marked hand hygiene stations (Marked by Yellow Circles on Map)

- Your written plan for each of your venues (ex. Football stadium, basketball court, volleyball court, cross country course) (must follow all state mandate/orders)

## MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL EVENTS

- Social Distancing requirements for sports
  - Designated 6 ft markings on bleachers. Signs posted at Main Gym Entrance and by seating area. Social Distancing requirements also posted on Lobby Bulletin Boards.
  - Hand Sanitizer Wall Dispenser available at each entrance and exit. Additional dispensers in lobby and hallways. Bottles of hand sanitizer will be used for participants in between games.
  - Posting of Facility Hours is online at [www.tuscymca.org](http://www.tuscymca.org) . Program Schedule is also available online. Restrooms/Locker Rooms clearly marked on Wall Signage.
  
- Enforcement

- Player, Coaches, Trainers and Officials
  - Players, coaches, trainers, and officials must conduct daily symptom assessment before each practice and game
  - Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home
  - Coaches and players must be educated on Covid-19 (provide documentation of how you will do this) – Education provided at parent meeting held on November 7, 2020 via Zoom. Slides can be downloaded [here](#). Parents will also be emailed and encouraged to review COVID protocols on the YMCA sports site [www.quickcores.com/tuscymca](http://www.quickcores.com/tuscymca) prior to the first game. Education will also be provided at the coaches meeting on November 12<sup>th</sup>.
  - Players must wear facial coverings when not on the field of play. (standard documented exemptions apply)
  - YMCA staff, coaches, and volunteers must wear facial coverings at all times.
  - No congregating before or after practice/game.
  - Volunteer coaches and YMCA staff will help monitor social distancing
  
- Spectators
  - Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments
  - Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home
  - Family and household members should sit together in groups of up to 4. These groups must be socially distanced from each other
  - No congregating before or after practice/game.
  - Masks are required unless otherwise exempt from masking requirements.
  
- Practice/Game/Tournaments
  - 6-foot distance must be maintained when not in play
  - Players, coaches, trainers, and officials should not physically contact each other except for play.
  - No team shall play against more than a single opponent in a 24-hour period
  - Do not share drinks, food, towels, or facial coverings

- Sports Facilities
  - The compliance officer for this event is Bob Fair.
  - Restrooms/Locker Room signage displayed for social distancing and masks.
  - All high touch points such as door handles and bleacher seats cleaned after each group.
  - Restroom/locker room high touch points cleaned every two hours or more
  
- Travel and busing
  - There will be no traveling for this league. All participants are transported to and from the YMCA by parents/guardians.
  
- Suspected and Confirmed Cases
  - Players, coaches, trainers, and officials must comply with Local Health Department (LHD) and aid them.
  - Players, coaches, trainers, and officials must comply with isolation and quarantine requirements from LHD
  - Players, coaches, trainers, and officials must maintain records of symptom checks and travel
  
- Limitation on Spectators at Venues
  - All players are asked to enter and exit at designated doorways for proper one-way traffic flow. Signage is posted.
  - Participants are limited to no more than 2 adults per game to enable social distancing on bleachers
  
- Signage and Education

  - Covid Protocol Materials posted Main Lobby bulletin boards and Gym Lobby bulletin board as well as in locker rooms and restrooms.
  
- Sick/Symptomatic People
  - Any player, coach, or YMCA staff exhibiting symptoms will be asked to immediately leave the gymnasium. Adults will be asked to leave YMCA property. Children will be isolated from other players, staff, and spectators until a parent arrives to take them home.
  
- Concession
  - There will not be a concession stand, nor are snacks permitted to be passed out or shared.

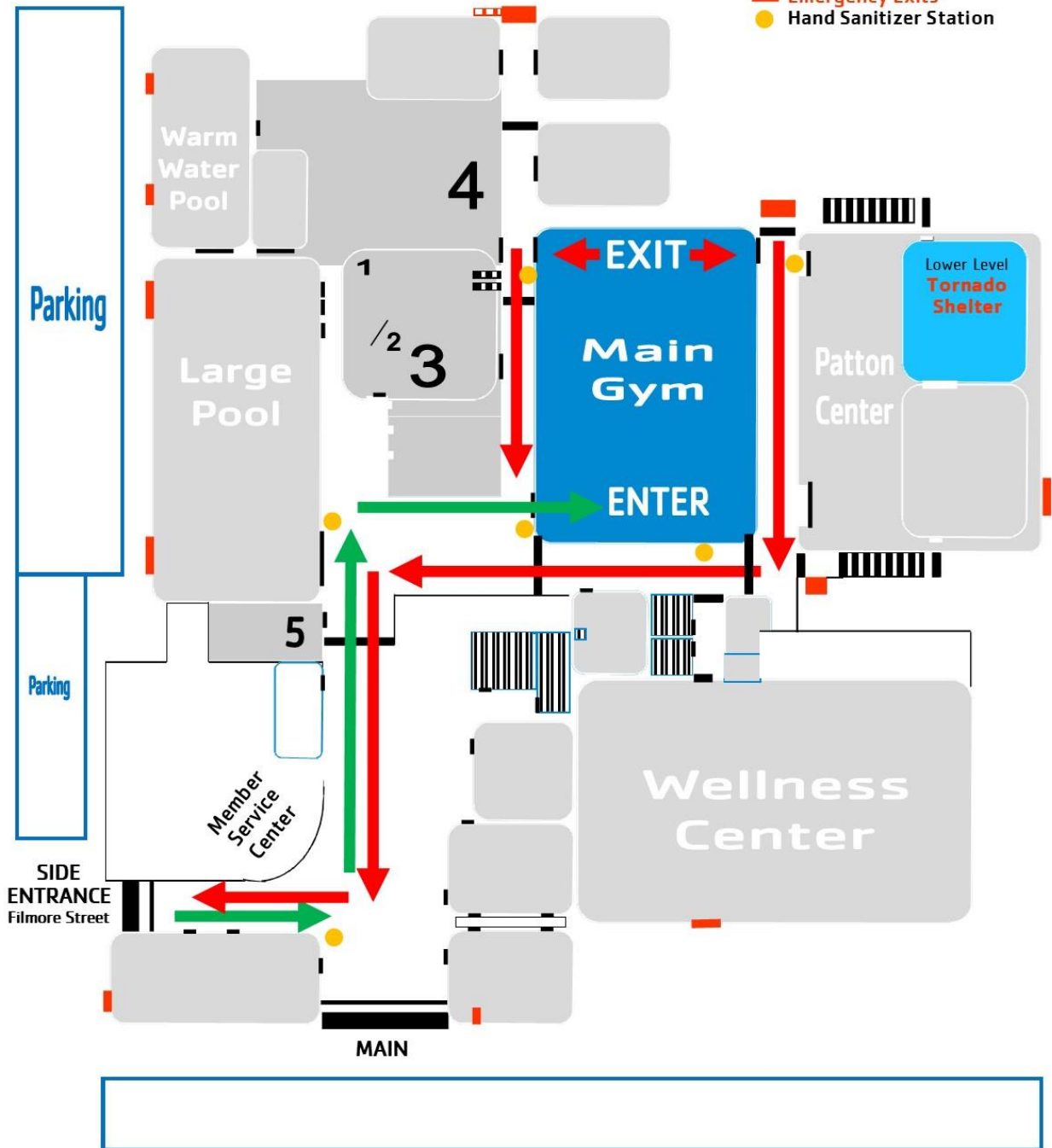
